

Checklist: Return Mobile Housing Unit

Totalrent

To ensure the housing unit can be collected smoothly and without additional costs, we kindly ask you to check off the points below before we pick up the unit.

Please note: If upon arrival the unit is found not to have been prepared according to these instructions, we will charge € 250 in cleaning costs.

Kitchen & Sanitation

Refrigerator: Completely empty, defrosted, and cleaned. Leave the door ajar (place a chair between the door if necessary) to prevent mold growth.	
Oven: Thoroughly cleaned.	
Kitchen surfaces: All cabinets and the countertop have been wiped down and are free of food scraps.	
Sanitation: The shower and toilet have been thoroughly cleaned. Taps and tiles are descaled. Shower walls and seams have been treated with bleach or mold remover. Remove shower curtains.	

Walls & Floor

Walls: All walls have been wiped down. Stains, fly spots, and other dirt have been removed (including on the ceiling).	
Floor: The floor has been completely swept/vacuumed and mopped.	

General & Technical

Trash: All trash bins have been emptied.	
Water: If applicable, the boiler is empty and the pipes have been drained.	
Boiler: The boiler has been switched off and is free of water.	
Toilet: Before disconnecting the water, flush the toilet 5 times.	

Inventory (What must remain?)

Remove all your personal belongings. Only the following standard items must remain in the unit:

Ladders (for the bunk beds)	
A squeegee	
Trash bin	
TV remote control	
Chairs (2 or 4 pieces, depending on the unit type)	
Smoke detectors	

What else comes with the housing unit?

2x Power cable connection 220v	
1x Water supply hose with couplings	
1x Water drain hose with coupling	
1x Hitch lock	
Key set consisting of a lanyard, hitch lock key, and housing unit key
